RULES FOR EXHIBITORS .

1. The membership fee shall be £2.00 per Annum.
2. Late Entries will be accepted.
3. Only one entry per person per class (except where otherwise stated).
4. All exhibits must be grown in the Exhibitors garden or allotments, except in the Children or Floral Art Sections.
5. The committee shall have the power to visit exhibitors' gardens prior to or after the Show.
6. The opening times of Hall for staging and show times will be published in the Schedule.
7. The exhibitors must show all Cut Flower exhibits in Society Vases.
8. The judges are empowered to withhold or modify prizes where the exhibits are considered unworthy. The judges decision as to the merits of the exhibits shall be final.
9. Every exhibit must have a G.H.S. entry card. These can be obtained from the Secretary's desk.
10. Any exhibitor having an objection or protest must intimate the same in writing to the Secretary, **no later than 3pm on the day of the Show with 50p**. The question will be submitted to a committee of the society whose decision will be final and binding in every case. Fee will be forfeited in the event of the finding of the committee adverse to the protester.
11. **All** exhibits must remain in the hall until the close of the show when the hall will be cleared of all visitors. Each exhibitor and assistant will be allowed 15 minutes to collect all exhibits retained by them. During that time the doors will be closed and no exhibit removed from the hall until authority is given by the official to do so. **To protect exhibits this rule will be strictly adhered to.**
12. No person will be allowed into the hall during judging except those officially engaged.
13. A stall will be opened for the receipt of flowers fruit and vegetables not intended for competition and will be sold for the benefit of the society's funds. Donations in this way shall be gratefully received.
14. Prize money and special awards at all our shows will be paid on receipt of claim form in the secretary's room from 3pm on the day of the shows.
15. All prizes not claimed within 14 days of the shows will be regarded as a donation to the society's funds.
16. Competitors are requested to name their exhibits as far as possible.
17. Any exhibit wishing to be retained by the exhibitor shall inform the Secretary who will attach a suitable label. All exhibits are for sale unless properly marked.
18. The committee reserves the right to refuse any entry without explanation.
19. The committee reserves the right to substitute value prizes for cash.
20. In the event of a tie for a points award, the competitor with the most first prizes will be given the award.
